



## SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Students are eligible to apply for consideration by a committee appointed by the respective principal or headmaster of the school. Prospective applicants must be:

- U.S. citizen or permanent resident;
- A senior in high school;
- Carry a minimum 2.5 GPA at the time of application;
- Planning to enroll full-time during the subsequent academic year at an accredited four-year or two-year degree granting institution in the United States.

The Reynolds Plantation Foundation Scholarship is a need-based scholarship awarded each year to eligible students at:

- Greene County High School
- Morgan County High School
- Putnam County High School
- Nathanael Greene Academy
- Gatewood Schools

Each scholarship is **renewable** and has a value of \$1,000, payable in two installments. It is to be used towards tuition, room and board, books or related fees. Checks will be made payable to the student and the college or university the student is to enter. \$500 will be awarded when a copy of the class registration is received for the first quarter of college. The second payment of \$500 will be awarded upon the Foundation's receipt of a photocopy of the student's first quarter grades and a photocopy of the second quarter registration. Reynolds Plantation Foundation will pay the award directly to the college subject to the requirement that the college agrees to use the grant funds to defray the expenses on behalf of the person who has been awarded this scholarship.

## **ELIGIBILITY**

- Graduating senior with a grade point average of 2.5.
- Graduate plans to attend an accredited two- or four-year college or university. A letter of acceptance from the college or university must be provided to Reynolds Plantation Foundation after the winner has been selected and before the scholarship check is paid.
- Applications will be accepted at the high school counselor's office on or before April 1 in accordance with the high school's scholarship application process. School is responsible for making students aware of this scholarship. Applications will be received through the end the school day or no later than 3:30 p.m. on April 1.
- Application is to be accompanied by a **handwritten** one-page essay entitled "Why Obtaining a College Degree is Important to Me".

## **TERMS**

Recipient will receive a \$1,000 scholarship payable in two installments. Check will be made payable to the student and the college or university the student is to enter. \$500 will be awarded when a copy of the class registration is received for the first quarter of college for the student's freshman year. The second payment of \$500 will be awarded upon the Foundation's receipt of a photocopy of the student's first quarter grades and a photocopy of the second quarter registration.

This is an annual scholarship, **renewable for up to four years**, provided the student is enrolled full-time, and is a student in good standing.

The initial scholarship award will be presented to each recipient at their respective school's annual awards night in May.

A representative from the Reynolds Plantation Foundation will make the presentation to the college-bound student at the school's annual awards night, schedule permitting.

The recipient will be asked to send a letter to Reynolds Plantation Foundation no later than June 30 of the following year to summarize the successes, challenges, and/or opportunities met during his or her freshman year at college.

No substitution or transfer of award by winner. All federal, state, and local taxes are the sole responsibility of the recipient.
